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**SUBJECT**

Control No. 316315: Re request by application dated 5-29-07 to renew License No. 13-32007-01, which currently authorizes storage of portable gauges at the licensee's facilities located at 525 West Washington Avenue, South Bend, Indiana and for use at temporary jobsites anywhere in the U. S. where the NRC maintains jurisdiction for regulating the use of licensed material.

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**SUMMARY**

In our telephone conversation, the following items were discussed:

1. I related that the renewal application (NRC FORM 313) submitted, did not address Item 3., "Address where licensed material will be used or possessed". If it is to be used or possessed at your current mailing address (525 West Washington Avenue, South Bend, Indiana) and used at temporary job sites of the licensee anywhere in the United States where the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission maintains jurisdiction for regulating the use of licensed material, please so state, or otherwise specify the requested location(s) of use.
2. In accord with our current criteria, to specify possession limits to be placed on the license for each radionuclide possessed, please indicate the possession limit you are requesting for both Cs-137 and Am-241.
3. Further, I noted that NUREG-1556, Vol. 1, Rev. 1, "Program Specific Guidance About Portable Gauge Licenses", dated November 2001, is the current guidance document used in evaluating license applications for acceptable commitments. Because Items 7 through 11 of your renewal application makes commitments to an outdated draft reference document (Draft Regulatory Guide DG-0008) and also make several references to generalized commitments rather than specific commitments addressed in NUREG-1556, Vol. 1, Rev. 1, it was discussed and agreed that you resubmit Items 7 through 11 of your renewal application using the check list format as presented in Appendix B. of NUREG-1556, Vol. 1, Rev. 1. This will basically confirm that your procedures and commitments will meet the guidance criteria in NUREG-1556, Vol. 1, Rev. 1.
4. I also requested that the response be signed by a high level management representative, or alternatively, that a document be included with the response, signed by a high level management representative, authorizing you, as the RSO, to sign documents for the licensee, relating to the NRC licensed program.
