By letter dated December 3, 1981 from R. L. Tedesco to H. G. Parris, TVA was notified of NRC approval of the Watts Bar Nuclear Plant Guard Training and Qualification Plan. As specified by the referenced letter, this plan will go into effect February 1, 1982 with all security employees to be qualified before fuel loading.

The subject letter also specified NRC approval of the Watts Bar Safeguards Contingency Plan and requested that this plan be implemented by January 2, 1982 as "required by 10 CFR 73.40(b)." It is our understanding that the requirement in 10 CFR 73.40(b), for implementation 30 days after NRC approval, applies to operating plants only. Since the Safeguards Contingency Plan is not needed during construction, it is TVA's intent to implement this plan upon receipt of an operating license.
