



1. Safeguards Information is stored in one of the following containers.
  - A. GSA-approved locking cabinets
  - B. File cabinet with locking bar and GSA-approved combination lock
  - C. Drawing tank with hasp and GSA-approved combination lock
  - D. Remington Rand No. 81341, four-drawer, metal, safe-file cabinets, equipped with UL Spec 768, Group 1R, Sargent Greenleaf, Inc., combination lock. Diebolt No. -- 7110-00-251-9107, four-drawer, fireproof, metal filing cabinet, equipped with Mil Spec S-L-15596-E Types I and II, Model 8550MP Sargent Greenleaf, Inc., combination lock. These cabinets are considered acceptable in lieu of either the metal file cabinets with locking bars and GSA-approved combination locks and GSA-approved security containers.
2. New Information is marked as Safeguards Information per 10 CFR 73.21  
  
Old Information is marked/remarked when used (i.e., change ("proprietary" to "Safeguards Information"))
3. Transfer of Safeguards Information is properly secured
4. Procedures are presently in place that ensure proper protection of Safeguards Information. We are in the process of revising procedures and conducting training programs to ensure consistent handling and compliance with 10 CFR 73.21. This effort will be completed by January 31, 1983.
