Thanks for the additional information. Regarding my thoughts, since we have not seen the report we can not comment on it. I hope that we get the opportunity to review it before Entergy commits to sampling only LAF-2. Otherwise we will explore the possibility of continued collection the other two LAF wells with Entergy. If we can determine that the report satisfactorily makes the case that LAF-1 and 3 are inappropriate for off-site sampling then we can support the anticipated GZA recommendation, but until that time we would prefer to continue to sample all three wells.

Dear Tim,

To continue the discussion we had recently, apparently GZA is recommending only LaFarge well no. 2 for future offsite monitoring as it is the only LaFarge well deep enough to provide any meaningful information. This recommendation supposedly will be in the Final Report, which we have not seen. I would want all of our hydrologists to look at this. In talking with Pat Donohue, Don Mayer gave him direction to sample all 3 LaFarge wells this quarter for the last time, so we are going along with this final set of 3. Your thoughts?

Attached is the updated monitoring well sample schedule. Please note that during this coming quarter we will be taking additional samples to meet a NYSDEC request for liquid and soil samples at various well locations. These samples are unrelated to the ongoing ground water investigation at IPEC and are mentioned as information only. These samples are represented by 'WP' on the schedule.

I have confirmed with Jim Noggle that the sample points of interest that are to be routinely split sampled are:
Lafarge 1, 2 & 3
MW-60, 62, 63, 66, & 67
All NRC samples will be sealed with evidence tape and documented on NRC Form 303 'Request for Analysis and Chain of Custody', as well as the

routine IPEC chain of custody form.

The NYSDEC sample points of interest that are to be routinely split sampled are:

Lafarge 1, 2 & 3

MW-60, 62, 63, 66, & 67

MW-40 & 51

All NYSDEC samples will be sealed with evidence tape and documented on the routine IPEC chain of custody form.

As always we will need to workout the logistics of which agency will observe each of these split samples.

In the short term we are scheduled to split sample MW-67 this Friday, and to split sample the three Lafarge wells the beginning of next month.

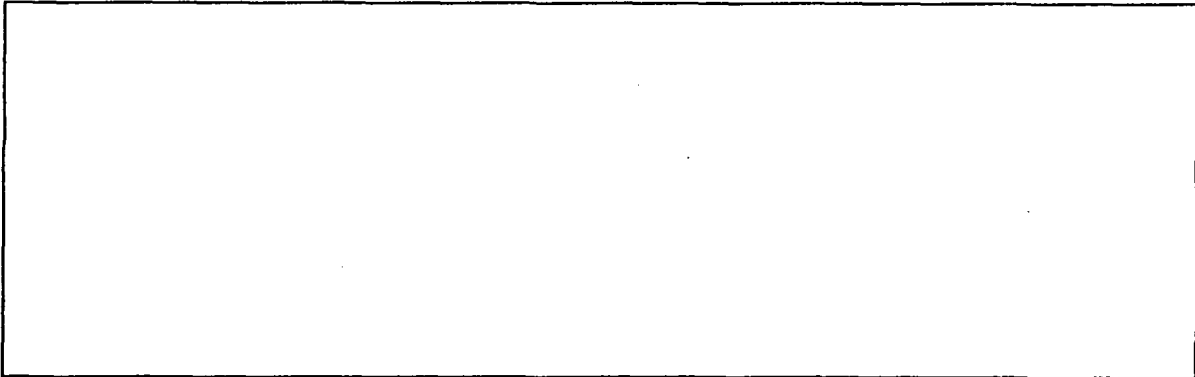
I'll get back to you when we have a firm date for the Lafarge samples.
