Please refer to TVA's letter dated September 4, 1984 which provided, in response to NRC Safety Evaluation Report confirmatory item 21, a summary of the data used to establish setpoints for the Watts Bar Nuclear Plant safety-related nuclear steam supply system equipment.

A conference call was held between TVA, Westinghouse (\underline{W}) and NRC representatives on January 16, 1985 to discuss apparent discrepancies between the FSAR, \underline{W} Statistical Setpoint Study and draft unit 1 Technical Specifications. The enclosure to this letter formally provides TVA responses to those questions discussed in the subject conference call. In responding to these questions, it was determined that revisions to the FSAR would be necessary. These FSAR revisions will be included in Amendment 55.

Please note that part of the information enclosed is proprietary to \underline{W} (proprietary information is marked and bracketed). As such, this information is supported by the enclosed affidavit (AW-76-60) and \underline{W} authorization letter (CAW-85-010) signed by \underline{W} , the owner of the information. The affidavit sets forth the basis on which the information may be withheld from public disclosure by the Commission and addresses with specificity the considerations listed in paragraph (b)(4) of Section 2.790 of the Commission's regulations.

Accordingly, it is respectively requested that the information which is proprietary to \underline{W} be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR Section 2.790 of the Commission's regulations.
