SUBJECT: FURTHER CLARIFICATION REGARDING REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

DATED FEBRUARY 12, 1989 FOR CONTAINMENT ISOLATION - WATTS BAR NUCLEAR

PLANT, UNITS 1 AND 2

This is in response to TVA's request during a telecon on February 17, 1989 regarding compliance of Watts Bar Engineering Safety Feature Systems Isolation provisions with Standard Review Plan (SRP) 6.2.4, Section II.6.e. The clarification is provided as follows:

Provide comparison of the Watts Bar Containment Isolation provisions of a closed system outside containment with the guidelines of SRP 6.2.4, Section II.6.e. The SRP acknowledges in Section II.6.e that for closed systems outside containment, the isolation valve is also located outside containment. TVA has informed the staff that for a significant number of closed systems outside containment the isolation valve is located inside containment, in order to satisfy the isolation requirements of General Design Criteria 55 and 56. Identify all closed systems with isolation valves inside containment and confirm that the required evaluation provisions are satisfied. When providing this information, you may refer to prior submittals that address this subject with respect to the acceptance criteria of SRP Section 6.2.4, Section II.6.e.

In order to complete our review in a timely manner, please provide this information within 45 days of receipt of this letter. If you have any questions or are unable to meet the requested response date, please contact R. Auluck at (301) 492-0759.
