On August 3, 1979, M. J. Gouge, NRC-OIE Region II, was informed that the
subject nonconformance was determined to be reportable in accordance
with 10 CFR 50.55(e). This was followed by our interim reports dated
September 4 and November 24, 1979, for Yellow Creek Nuclear Plant. This
nonconformance has since been determined applicable for Sequoyah, Watts
Bar, Bellefonte, Hartsville, and Phipps Bend Nuclear Plants. Enclosed
is our combined final report.
