The subject deficiency was initially reported to NRC-OIE Inspector M. J. Gouge on March 24, 1980, in accordance with 10 CFR 50.55(e). An interim report was submitted on April 23, 1980. We expect to submit our next report by September 11, 1980.

Westinghouse has not completed the evaluation of the guide tube pins taken from an operating plant. TVA and Westinghouse are proceeding with plans to replace the pins at Sequoyah unit 2 and Watts Bar units 1 and 2 so as not to impact the current construction schedule. If, however, the evaluation is finished before the pins are replaced and if the evaluation determines that pin replacement is not necessary, then the pins may not be replaced.
