This letter is to confirm the findings of the NRC Caseload Forecast Panel resulting from the March 2-4, 1983, site visit to assess construction completion schedules for the Watts Bar Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2. On the basis of the plant tour and the presentations made by TVA, the panel concluded that the earliest fuel load date for Unit 1 is June 1984. Since the fuel load date for a second unit is nominally projected to be 18 months after completion of the first unit, the CFP has determined a December 1985 fuel load date for Unit 2. The March 25, 1983, meeting summary describes the meeting agenda and information supporting the panel's conclusion.

As discussed during the exit meeting, the staff establishes its licensing schedule on the applicant's completion date. In light of your revised fuel load schedule for Unit 1 (January 1984), and the delayed amendment to the Watts Bar FSAR, we have scheduled issuance of the next supplement to the Watts Bar Safety Evaluation Report (SER. NUREG-0847) in November 1983. The NRC staff will continue its review of your application upon receipt of information from your staff to ensure NRC licensing actions will not impact the fuel load date of your facility.
