By letters to you dated April 22 and November 30, 1982 and July 1, 1983, TVA provided milestone schedules for the prompt notification system at Watts Bar Nuclear Plant. The current status is as follows:

All fixed sirens have been installed with deficiencies identified in the initial checkout currently being corrected. One of these sirens was destroyed by vandalism requiring the procurement of a replacement.

The State of Tennessee has identified the mobile siren routes.

The revised contract is in place with the State of Tennessee which addresses the prompt notification system.

Funds have been provided to the State of Tennessee for the purchase of tone-alert radios.

TVA now expects to declare the system operational on April 1, 1984.
