By L. M. Mills' letter to you dated February 6, 1984, TVA provided information on Watts Bar Nuclear Plant concerning NUREG-0612, "Control of Heavy Loads at Nuclear Power Plants." The enclosure to that letter specified that four lifting devices would be either reworked or purchased by September 1, 1984. These devices are identified on pages 17 and 18 of the enclosure as device numbers LD2, LD4, LD7, and LD11. Design changes to these devices after contract issuance have resulted in a delay in the expected delivery date. Accordingly, TVA now anticipates replacement of these devices by March 5, 1985.
