Please refer to H. L. Thompson's letter to H. G. Parris dated July 22, 1985 concerning documents received which the NRC intends to place in the NRC Public Document Room (PDR). Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations Part 2.790(a)(6) provides that personnel and medical files and similar files which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy may be excepted from disclosure and not placed in the PDR. For this reason, we request that item number 6 entitled, "Tennessee Valley Authority Nuclear Safety Review Staff Employee Concern Investigation NSRS Report No. I-84-10-NPS, "Allegation of Colorblindness of Nuclear Plant Employees," June 13, 1984 (Administratively Confidential), not be placed in the PDR. We believe that the document could allow the identification of personnel and their medical records. We therefore offer another version of the same report (enclosed) which is not considered to be administratively confidential. Please return or destroy the copy you currently have in your possession.
