WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT (WBN) - HEAT TREATING ON U-BEND PORTION OF STEAM GENERATOR TUBES

In my July 22, 1986 letter to you, we informed you of TVA's intent to perform heat treating on the U-bend portion of the WBN steam generator tubes. This process reduces residual stresses and enhances resistance to primary water stress corrosion cracking. T. J. Kenyon of the your staff has requested additional information on this program. In response, enclosed are:

- Fifteen copies of WCAP-11177, Row 1 and Row 2 U-bend Heat Treatment, Licensing Report, for the Watts Bar Nuclear Plants Units 1 & 2, Proprietary Class 2 (Proprietary), prepared by Westinghouse dated July 1986.
- 2 Fifteen copies of WCAP-11176, Row 1 and Row 2 U-Bend Heat Treatment, Licensing Report, for the Watts Bar Nuclear Plants Units 1 & 2, Proprietary Class 3 (Non-Proprietary) prepared by Westinghouse dated July 1986.

Also enclosed is a Westinghouse Application for Withholding, CAW-86-064, accompanying affidavit, and Proprietary Information Notice.

As this submittal contains information proprietary to Westinghouse Electric Corporation, it is supported by an affidavit signed by Westinghouse, the owner of the information. The affidavit sets forth the basis on which the information may be withheld from public disclosure by the Commission and addresses with specificity the considerations listed in paragraph (b)(4) of Section 2.790 of the Commission's regulations.

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Accordingly, it is respectfully requested that the information which is proprietary to Westinghouse be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR Section 2.790 of the Commission's regulations.
