WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT (WBN) - RESPONSE TO NRC REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL  
INFORMATION PERTAINING TO RTD BYPASS MANIFOLD REMOVAL

Your letter to S. A. White dated January 16, 1987 requested additional  
information on RTD Bypass Manifold Removal at WBN. The questions are based on  
the joint NRC/TVA/Westinghouse meeting in Bethesda, Maryland, on October 14,  
1986, and our December 1, 1986 submittal to NRC of revisions to FSAR chapters  
5 and 7.

Enclosure 1 provides two copies of Response to NRC Request for Additional  
Information, RTD Bypass Modification on Watts Bar, dated February 1987  
(proprietary).

Enclosure 2 provides two copies of Response to NRC Request for Additional  
Information, RTD Bypass Modification dated February 1987 (nonproprietary).

Also enclosed is a Westinghouse Application For Withholding, CAW-87-011,  
Accompanying Affidavit, and Proprietary Information Notice (enclosure 3).

As this submittal contains information proprietary to Westinghouse Electric  
Corporation, it is supported by an affidavit signed by Westinghouse, the owner  
of the information. The affidavit sets forth the basis on which the  
information may be withheld from the public disclosure by the Commission and  
addresses with specificity the considerations listed in paragraph (b)(4) of  
Section 2.790 of the Commission's regulations.

Accordingly, it is respectfully requested that the information which is  
proprietary to Westinghouse be withheld from public disclosure in accordance  
with 10 CFR Section 2.790 of the Commission's regulations. Correspondence
