Enclosed are the subject licenses issued against your request for Cesium 137 sealed sources.

As far as we are able to determine, your application of November 6, 1956 is a duplication of an earlier application submitted by the Houston office. We are enclosing a reproduced copy of the latter application, as requested in your letter of November 27, 1956. Original copies of License No. 42-682-1 were sent to George Wiley, Chief Engineer, Ideal Cement Company. Since the June 6 application, on which this license was issued, was not coordinated through your office, we have superseded License No. 42-682-1 with License No. 5-682-1. The latter license names the Denver office as licensee and provides for use of byproduct material at the Houston plant. Original file copies of License No. 42-682-1 should either be destroyed or returned to this office.

License No. 5-682-2 names the Denver office as licensee and provides for use of byproduct material in your Baton Rouge plant. If you need additional byproduct material in either of the above mentioned locations, please submit a new application, and your license can be amended accordingly.
