By Reference 1, TVA provided a revised issue of the Seismic Analysis CAP for Watts Bar Unit 1 to NRC for review and concurrence. Enclosure 3 of Reference 1 provided TVA's response to the 9 comments/action items related to the seismic CAP, as documented in Reference 2. Item No. 7 of the 9 comments was a request that TVA provide a copy of the references justifying the use of damping values for conduit, cable tray, and heating, ventilating, and air conditioning (i.e., ANCO testing). As discussed with Tom Cheng of the NRC staff on October 31, 1989, this information will be ready for his review on November 13, 1989, when he is on site at WBN for the Seismic Analysis audit.
