In accordance with application dated April 11, 1963, License No. 5-682-6 is amended as follows:

change the expiration date (Item 4) from May 31, 1963, to May 31, 1965.

change the expiration symbol under the license number from (E63) to (E65).

revise Conditions 13 and 17 C to read:

- . Byproduct material shall be used by, or under the supervision of, D. F. Carlson, Bobby Joe McMullan, or J. L. Gilliland.
- C. If the test reveals the presence of 0.005 microcuries or more of removable contamination, the licensee shall immediately withdraw the sealed source from use and shall cause it to be decontaminated and repaired or to be disposed of in accordance with Commission regulations. A report shall be filed within 5 days of the test with the Director, Division of Licensing and Regulation, U. S. Atomic Energy Commission, Washington 25, D. C., describing the equipment involved, the test results and the corrective action taken. A copy of such report shall also be sent to the Director, Region IV, Division of Compliance, USAEC, P. O. Box 15266, Denver 15, Colorado.
