Dear Mr. Williams:

It has come to our attention that Amendment No. 07, to your NRC Material License No. 15-26803-01, issued on November 01, 2007, contained an error in that Item 3. incorrectly describes the licensing action (which, in part, extended the expiration date on the license to November 30, 2017) as an amendment (amended) rather than a renewal (renewed) of the license. Enclosed is a corrected copy of Amendment No. 07 of your NRC license, reflecting the licensing action, in License Item 3., as a renewal of the license. We apologize for any inconvenience this oversight may have caused you.

NRC's Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2005-31 provides criteria to identify security-related sensitive information and guidance for handling and marking of such documents. This ensures that potentially sensitive information is not made publicly available through ADAMS, the NRC's electronic document system. Pursuant to NRC's RIS 2005-31 and in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, the enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.
