SUBJECT: WATTS BAR UNIT 1 -- DOCUMENTS ON PROJECT PLANS

During the past several months, we have obtained a number of project plans from your staff. These project plans are all related to the corrective active programs (CAPs) and special programs (SPs).

We have reviewed some and briefly looked at others and came to the conclusion that, since these are site documents and are subject to frequent changes, there is no reason at this time for NRR to docket and keep them. We are thus returning them to you by this letter.
