
## U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission

As discussed with the NRC Staff and in accordance with the guidelines of NRC Generic Letter 86-10, "Implementation of Fire Protection Requirements," TVA is relocating the Fire Protection Technical Specifications to the Technical Requirements Manual. Accordingly, a summary of the Fire Protection Program provided in the Enclosure (including the compartmentation drawings and a summary of the approved deviations from NRC guidelines, etc.) will be incorporated into the FSAR, once the program is reviewed and approved by NRC. Documentation to support the future FSAR amendment is available onsite for NRC review.

Section V of this report provides TVA's deviations from the applicable NRC guidelines and their associated justifications. TVA requests NRC's review and concurrence with these deviations as well as the enclosed Fire Protection Report at the Staff's earliest convenience.
