SUBJECT: WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT - FIRE PROTECTION REPORT
(TAC M63648)

By letter dated February 5, 1992, Mr. John H. Garrity of your site staff provided NRC with the Fire Protection Report generated as a result of the comprehensive review TVA conducted to implement the Fire Protection Corrective Action Program (CAP) Plan. He stated that the fire protection program ensures Watts Bar's compliance with (1) Appendix A to Branch Technical Position 9.5-1, dated July 1, 1976, and (2) Sections III.G, J, and O of Appendix R to 10 CFR Part 50. Our reviewer, Mr. Patrick Madden, was on site February 28, 1992, to meet with your fire protection personnel.

By this letter, we acknowledge that the February 5, 1992 report supersedes previous TVA fire protection commitments and submittals, as well as the present Fire Protection Program described in the Final Safety Analysis Report. We will keep TVA personnel informed of the progress of this review through monthly licensing status meetings, technical meetings (if needed) and conference calls.
