SUBJECT: WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT - CONFORMANCE WITH REGULATORY GUIDE 1.97,
REVISION 2 (TAC M77550 and M77551)

Generic Letter 82-33 requested utilities to provide a report to the NRC describing how the post-accident monitoring instrumentation at each plant meets the guidelines of Regulatory Guide 1.97, Revision 2, as applied to emergency response facilities. This issue was tracked as Outstanding Issue 26 in the Watts Bar SER, Supplement 7. TVA provided information by letters dated January 30, 1984 and April 16, 1985. These submittals were replaced by a letter dated August 31, 1990, which was supplemented by letters dated October 11, 1990, January 3, 1991 and October 29, 1991.

We have completed our review of your submitted information and find TVA either conforms with, or has provided acceptable justifications for deviations from the guidance of Regulatory Guide 1.97, Revision 2. Details of our findings will be published in the Watts Bar SER Supplement 9.

This completes our work on the subject issue. The status of Outstanding Issue 26 will be appropriately updated in SER Supplement 9.
