SUBJECT: WATTS BAR UNIT 1 - SUPPLEMENTAL SAFETY EVALUATION ON CORRECTIVE ACTION PROGRAM FOR CABLES (TAC M71917)

Our safety evaluation on the corrective action program (CAP) for cables was issued by letter dated April 25, 1991, and as Appendix P of SER Supplement 7. In the safety evaluation, we addressed the issue of cable proximity to hot pipes but at that time had not reviewed the models TVA used to establish acceptable clearances between electrical cables and hot pipes. This issue was discussed in the site audit of March 2, 1992.

We have completed review of calculation WBN-OSG4-138, "Class 1E Electrical Cable/Hot Pipe Clearance Requirements", and found the models and assumptions used at Watts Bar to determine electrical cable temperatures reasonable for calculations of this type. All relevant physical phenomena appear to have been considered. We understand that TVA plans to verify the calculations during hot functional testing by performing temperature surveys of locations that might be subject to overheating.

This completes our work on the issue of cable proximity to hot pipes. Our report on the March 2, 1992 audit will be issued by separate correspondence.
