SUBJECT: WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT - PROGRAM FOR ASSURANCE OF COMPLETION AND ASSURANCE OF QUALITY (TAC M83748 and M83749)

The purpose of this letter is to acknowledge our receipt of your letter dated April 30, 1992, which transmitted a document describing the Program For Assurance Of Completion and Assurance Of Quality (PAC/AQ). The Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (NRR) staff has reviewed that document and is thus informed of your PAC/AQ.

Since the overall strategy of the entire PAC/AQ is to perform an in-depth review to provide reasonable assurance that commitments are met, it is NRR staff's position that the efficacy of the program will be reflected in the quality of implementation of various Watts Bar corrective action programs (CAPs), special programs (SPs) and other licensing commitments. The staff has ongoing inspection and audit activities to ascertain acceptable implementation of such activities. The quality of PAC/AQ will be judged by the staff's inspection/audit findings.

This completes the NRR staff's efforts on the Watts Bar PAC/AQ.
