The subject letter dated November 15, 1979, requested that TVA provide supplemental information with respect to the infraction on alignment bead welds. A response to this infraction was submitted on July 31, 1979.

The subject infraction was discussed with engineering and craft employees, and no reason was found to believe that a problem exists with craft employees performing unauthorized and undocumented alignment bead welds. Any unauthorized and undocumented alignment bead welds that are found will be nonconformed and dispositioned in accordance with approved procedures. Engineering employees have been instructed to be alert for evidence of such alignment bead welds when performing inspection activities. Training for steamfitter craft supervision, including reemphasis that no work is to be performed on safety-related piping without proper procedures, has recently been completed.
