
The subject deficiency was initially reported to NRC Region II Inspector Steve Weiss on December 9, 1985, in accordance with 10 CFR 50.55(e) as Nonconforming Condition Report (NCR) 6463. NCR W-333-P was later added to the scope of the identified deficiency. Previous interim reports were submitted on January 24, February 28, June 5, October 17, and November 17, 1986, and September 30, 1987. Our May 18, 1988 submittal revised the schedule for our final report to April 24, 1989.

Since our last interim report, a corrective action program (CAP) plan has been established and was submitted to NRC on November 18, 1988. The Electrical Conduit and Conduit Supports CAP was developed to ensure that the unit 1 safety-related conduit and conduit supports are structurally adequate and in compliance with licensing requirements.

We expect to submit our final report on or about April 30, 1990. The enclosure contains the commitment stated in this submittal.
