Duke Power Company LLC d/b/a Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (Duke) Oconee Nuclear Station Units 1, 2, & 3 Docket Nos. 50-269, 50-270, 50-287 NRC Generic Letter 2004-02 Supplement to Request for Schedule Relief

On December 19, 2007, Oconee Nuclear Station (ONS) was contacted by the NRC to discuss issues with ONS' revised request for relief dated December 18, 2007. ONS was requested to make three changes to the December 18, 2007, commitments. The requested changes were:

- 1) Separate the commitments for Unit 1 and 2 work from the Unit 3 outage schedule. Make specific commitments on a unit basis.
- 2) Revise the commitment for replacement of the 3A HPI pump to state that ONS will replace this pump earlier if a forced outage of sufficient duration should occur prior to the scheduled refueling outage.
- 3) Add a commitment to review procedural guidance which has been provided to operators and ensure the guidance addresses the recognition of (and response to) failures of the Low Pressure Injection (LPI), High Pressure Injection (HPI), or Building Spray (BS) pumps which have not been modified as required by the GL 2004-02 downstream effects evaluation. Should additional guidance be needed, provide an expected completion date.

Enclosure 1 to this letter contains the revised commitments discussed in our conference call.
