SUBJECT: MEETING SUMMARY FOR THE OCTOBER 11, 1988 MEETING BETWEEN NRC AND
TVA REGARDING THE WATTS BAR WELDING REVIEW PROGRAM

On October 11, 1988, a meeting was held in Rockville, Maryland at the request of NRC staff with the representatives of TVA for the purpose of discussing the status of TVA's welding review program for Watts Bar. Enclosure 1 is the list of attendees and Enclosure 2 is a copy of the transcript of the meeting. A copy of the handout provided by TVA at the meeting is also included in Enclosure 2.

Mr. James Partlow, Director, Office of Special Projects, NRC opened the meeting by summarizing NRC staff's understanding of the history of TVA's welding program at Watts Bar and Staff's review and evaluation of the EG&G Weld Evaluation Program (WEP) Report for Watts Bar Nuclear Plant (WBN), Unit 1. This evaluation of the WEP Report was transmitted to TVA on August 12, 1988. Mr. Partlow stated that one of the objectives of this meeting is to start with a common understanding of the status of welding at Watts Bar using the WEP report and discuss the various programs and changes that have been made in Quality Assurance (QA) to improve this area.

Mr. Steven White in his opening remarks reiterated that the purpose of the meeting is to discuss the status of welding activities at the Watts Bar facility. Mr. White summarized the various elements which deal with the WBN welding program and how they fit together. The WEP Report is only part of a comprehensive weld review program at Watts Bar. The meeting discussions on all topics are contained in the transcript of the meeting which is Enclosure 2 to this meeting summary.

In his concluding remarks, Mr. Partlow stated that the staff has a better understanding of the status of welding at Watts Bar and will be awaiting the submittal of the Corrective Action Program on welding.
