MEETING SUMMARY OF MAY 14, 1990 MEETING ON STATUS AND SCHEDULE SUBJECT:

OF VARIOUS LICENSING ACTIVITIES

On May 14, 1990, a meeting was held between the NRC staff and TVA's representatives in Rockville, Maryland. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the status and schedule of various licensing activities. Enclosure 1 is the list of individuals attending the meeting. Following is a summary of the items discussed:

### 1. Technical Specifications Review:

The NRC staff has initiated the review of the Watts Bar technical specifications. Over the next 3-4 months, a series of meetings will be held at the NRC office in Rockville, Maryland. Specific sections of the TSs will be discussed at these meetings. TVA will provide an updated copy of those sections 2 weeks prior to the meeting date.

### FSAR Review: 2.

According to TVA, June 1, 1990 is the target date for the next FSAR Amendment (No. 63). This amendment will incorporate all changes filed in the previous nine amendments. These were never reviewed by the NRC staff. TVA is targeting September 1990 date for the Amendment No. 64.

### 3. Unit 2 licensing:

Unit 2 is approximately 85 percent complete. TVA stated that whenever Unit 2 construction is reactivated, TVA will address all the programs required for the plants in the deffered status as stated in the Commission's policy on deffered plants.

#### 4. Watts Bar Program Team:

TVA stated that the scope of the WBPT has been expanded to include oversight activities for the implementation of the corrective actions and will also include the review of the closure of these actions.

#### 5. Vendor Information CAP:

The staff is reviewing the VI CAP and needs some clarification from TVA. A conference call will be arranged to discuss these questions/clarifications/ concerns.

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## 6. CAPs Status:

It was agreed that meetings should be arranged in June 1990 for TVA to provide status of various CAPs including CAP closure plans.

## 7. Fire Protection:

TVA is preparing a revision to the fire protection program and will be submitted to NRC in June 1990. Safe shutdown analysis will be completed by February 1991. This may result in some modifications.
