Bo and John,

I am having problems with the .pdf version of the LRA, the 1663 pg. main portion of the application. The highlighted blue links in the "Preface" to different sections of the technical/aging management portion of the application do not work. Combined with the absence of the "Bookmark" feature of Adobe, this means there is no logical way to link to different sections of the application. The Table of Contents is also not hyperlinked.

I understand this may be the format you received from Entergy, but I fail to understand why they would Bookmark the 943 pg. Environmental Report, and not the 1663 pg. main application. The lack of these features makes it very difficult and time-consuming to parse through such a large document efficiently.

I'd appreciate it if you could double check the website version, and let me know if these are problems you can resolve.
