Pilgrim Watch hereby requests that the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board consider resetting the schedule for the proceedings and extend all deadlines for filings thirty (30) days following complete information provided on event.

Pilgrim Watch's rationale is as follows. There has been a new development that has direct bearing on this case. It was reported to us by the Town of Duxbury that Dr. Thomas Sowden, health physicist Pilgrim NPS, informed a Duxbury Town official that Entergy had dug three boring holes, approximately 30 feet from the wall of the reactor building, and tests showed Tritium. It is important to afford Pilgrim Watch additional time to gain specific information on this occurrence so as to allow us to reformulate our Statement Position, Written Direct Testimony and Exhibits.
