In a letter dated November 30, 2007, the NRC extended the due date for submittal of supplemental responses to Generic Letter (GL) 2004-02 "Potential Impact of Debris Blockage on Emergency Recirculation during Design Basis Accidents at Pressurized-Water Reactors" from December 31, 2007 to February 29, 2008. In addition, in a letter dated November 8, 2007, the NRC provided expectations for future plant-specific extension requests to incorporate documentation of testing being completed in late 2007.

In a letter dated November 6, 2007, Duke Power Company LLC d/b/a Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (Duke), committed to providing all available information to the NRC in a supplemental response to GL 2004-02 [including responses to the February 9, 2006 Request for Additional Information (RAIs)] by December 31, 2007 and requested that the date for completing the corrective actions required by GL 2004-02 at McGuire Units 1 and 2 be extended to April 30, 2008 in order

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to complete the formal documentation of the Integrated Prototype (chemical effects) Testing (IPT).

Duke herein amends its November 6, 2007 letter by accepting the two month extension (to February 29, 2008) provided to all Pressurized Water Reactor licensees in the NRC's letter of November 30, 2007. As a result, Duke will provide all available information to the NRC in a supplemental response, including responses to the RAIs, by February 29, 2008.

As proposed by Duke's letter of November 6, 2007, any additional or revised information resulting from the IPT will be provided as an amended response to GL 2004-02 by April 30, 2008.

Enclosure 1 provides the regulatory commitments made in this letter.
