Subject: Modification of USNRC License No. 09-11149-03, License Application dated February 21, 2003

Dear Mr. Lawyer,

To facilitate our pending amendment request and subsequent to our phone discussions December 18, 2007 we submit the following request action:

1. We would like authorization for the flexibility to make program changes and changes to procedures specifically identified in documents which were previously approved by the Commission and incorporated into the license, without prior Commission approval.
 - a. Changes to our program and procedures will be limited to the following areas: training; audit program; radiation monitoring instruments; material receipt and accountability; safe use of radionuclides and emergency procedures; and radiation surveys. We will apply for, and receive an amendment to our license prior to implementing any other programmatic or procedural changes.
 - b. The proposed revision will be documented, reviewed, and approved by the Kennedy Space Center Radiation Safety Committee in accordance with established procedures prior to implementation.
 - c. The revised program will be in accordance with regulatory requirements, will not change the license conditions, and will not decrease the effectiveness of the Radiation Safety Program.
 - d. Our staff will be trained in the revised procedures prior to implementation.
 - e. Our audit program will evaluate the effectiveness of

the change and its implementation.

2. We also request that you delete item 6H through 9H on our current license that allows us possession of any byproduct material with atomic numbers 1 through 83, inclusive as sealed, plated or foil source not to exceed 100 Ci per radionuclide for collection and storage incident to transfer to authorized recipients.
