SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT 030-36572/07-01 AND NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Johnson:

This refers to the inspection conducted on October 23, 2007 through December 3, 2007, at your facility in Anchorage, Alaska. The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to safety and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of the license. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selected examination of procedures and representative records and interviews with personnel. Preliminary inspection findings were discussed with you at the conclusion of the onsite portion of the inspection and in person on December 3, 2007. A final exit briefing was conducted with you on January 7, 2008.

Based on the results of this inspection, the NRC has determined that one violation of NRC requirements occurred. This violation was evaluated in accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions" (Enforcement Policy). The current Enforcement Policy is included on the NRC's website at www.nrc.gov/OE. This violation involved the failure to amend the license to reflect a new storage location. This violation is being cited in the Notice because it was identified by the NRC, rather than being self-identified by the licensee. However, in light of your license amendment number 3, dated December 11, 2007, to reflect your current gauge storage location at 6710 Teshlar Drive, Anchorage Alaska and because the information regarding the reason for the violations, and the corrective actions taken are already adequately addressed on the docket, you are not required to respond to this letter or the enclosed Notice of Violation. We consider the matter closed.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter, Enclosure 1, and your response will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's document system (ADAMS), accessible from the Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>. NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Alaska Structural Inspection, LLC
Anchorage, Alaska

During a NRC inspection conducted from October 23 to December 3, 2007, one violation of NRC requirements was identified. In accordance with the Enforcement Policy, the violation is listed below:

- A. 10 CFR 30.34(c) requires, in part, that each licensee confine his possession and use of byproduct materials to the locations and purposes authorized by the license.

Condition 10.A. of License No. 50-27774-01 requires that licensed material be used or stored only at 340 East 4th Avenue, Anchorage Alaska.

Contrary to the above, from approximately January 15, 2007, to December 3, 2007, the licensee possessed a Troxler 3400 series portable gauge containing radioactive material at 6710 Teslar Drive, Anchorage, Alaska, a location not authorized by the license.

This is a Severity Level IV violation. (Supplement IV)

No response to this Notice of Violation is required. If you choose to respond, clearly mark your response as a "Reply to a Notice of Violation," and send it to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington, DC 20555 with a copy to the Regional Administrator, Region IV, at 611 Ryan Plaza Drive, Suite 400, Arlington, Texas 76011, within 30 days of the date of the letter transmitting this Notice of Violation (Notice).

Because your response, if any, will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's document system (ADAMS), accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>, to the extent possible, it should not include any personal privacy, proprietary, or safeguards information so that it can be made available to the public without redaction. If personal privacy or proprietary information is necessary to provide an acceptable response, then please provide a bracketed copy of your response that identifies the information that should be protected and a redacted copy of your response that deletes such information. If you request withholding of such material, you must specifically identify the portions of your response that you seek to have withheld and provide in detail the bases for your claim of withholding (e.g., explain why the disclosure of information will create an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy or provide the information required by 10 CFR 2.390(b) to support a request for withholding confidential commercial or financial information)
