Gentlemen:

Receipt is acknowledged of your request of March 9, 1961, for an amendment to License C-4283.

Enclosed is a copy each of AEC Regulations 10 CFR 20 and 10 CFR 40 entitled "Standards for Protection Against Radiation" and "Licensing of Source Material", respectively. Compliance with Part 20 is made a condition of all material licenses issued by the Commission.

In addition to the information you have submitted, we require the following information which should be submitted in letter form, in quadruplicate.

- (1) The maximum quantity of source material you wish to possess at any one time.
- (2) A detailed description of the activities you will perform.
- (3) The procedures you intend to employ in safeguarding employees against dust and contamination exposure through the escape of radioactive materials in the use of such material.
- (4) A general description of the types of instruments you have available to perform necessary health and safety surveys and the surveys that will be conducted.
- (5) If waste products are anticipated, the volume and concentration of radioactive materials and the method by which you intend to dispose of this waste.
