Dear Dr. DeLisle:

On December 19, 2007, Steven Courtemanche of my staff contacted you by telephone regarding the status of the NRC license issued to Central Virginia Laboratories and Consultants, Inc. (CVLCI). Your firm and facility were identified on the CVLCI license and your facility was inspected by NRC on February 22-23, 2007 as part of the CVLCI inspection. During the telephone conversation with Mr. Courtemanche, you explained that CVLCI never received radioactive material under the NRC license. Mr. Courtemanche requested that you submit a letter on behalf of CVLCI documenting that no radioactive material had been possessed so that the license could be retired. We received your letter dated December 21, 2007.

In processing your December 21 letter, my staff discovered that on March 5, 2007, we had received a letter from Mr. Adrian Mood, CVLCI President, requesting that the license be retired and that the license was retired within a few days after receiving Mr. Mood's letter. Unfortunately, the license database was not updated at the time to reflect the retirement of the license. Had this been completed accurately, Mr. Courtemanche would not have been prompted to contact you. We thank you for your cooperation and regret any inconvenience this may have caused you.



We were to conduct aquatic toxicity tests on wastewater samples from some federal facilities in Kentucky. We never received any samples to test and so no licensed material was ever possessed by our laboratory.
