Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 40.26 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 10 - Atomic Energy, Chapter 1, Part 40, The Martin Company hereby requests that Source Material License No. C-4283, dated September 15, 1958, be extended for a period of one year from September 30, 1959 to September 30, 1960.

We anticipate that we shall have to procure an additional 25,000 pounds of HK31A alloy during the one year period ending September 30, 1960. Accordingly, it is requested that said license be further revised to increase the amount of Thorium-magnesium alloy (containing not more than 4% Thorium) from 50,000 pounds to 75,000 pounds.


