It is requested that Byproduct Material License No. 19-1398-19 be amended as follows:


Item 8A - Change maximum amount of radioactivity to read: Two sources not to exceed 50 curies per source.

This change is requested to permit use of a 50 curie Iridium 192 source in the Technical Operations, Inc. Model 412 projector. It is understood that the manufacturer of this projector has filed specifications with your office and that the use of the projector with a 50 curie source will conform to standards of Title 10 CFR Part 20.


