Gentlemen:

Please establish an allocation for 5000 kgs of approximately 5% enriched Uranium to be used by Martin Marietta in the fabrication of the 10,000 K W Floating Nuclear Power Plant designated MH-1A. This allocation is equivalent to 250 kgs U-235. The fabrication will be performed under the Martin Marietta Corporation Special Nuclear Material License Number 53 in accordance with Lease Number 144 with the AEC, under prime Contract DA-36-109-ENG-7454 with the U. S. Army, Corps of Engineers.

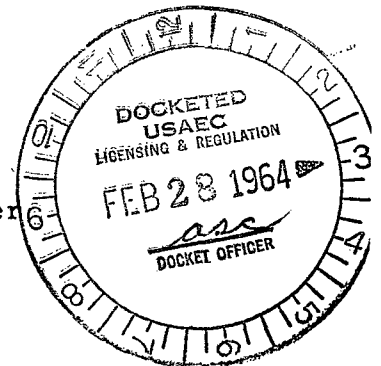
Conversion of UF₆ to UO₂ and subsequent pellet fabrication, which is scheduled for April, 1964, will be performed by a vendor yet to be selected by Martin.

It is the sole purpose of this letter to establish an allocation for the U-235 at this time to assure that proper authorizations are in effect for the withdrawal of the UF₆ when it is needed in April.
