Dear Mr. Schmidt:

ALARON intends to establish a temporary job site per conditions 10 and 15 of our 37-20826-01 license at the facility of Electric Motor & Contracting Company, Inc. (EMC) for approximately 30 days starting on or after January 15, 2008.

Our contact person at EMC for this job is Bill Newell, EMC nuclear operations manager.

The occasion for this temporary job site is the balancing and testing of a reactor coolant recirculation pump electric motor from FENOC's Perry nuclear power plant. We have disassembled, decontaminated, rewound, and painted the motor at Alaron's Wampum facility, but low-level fixed contamination on the rotor and inaccessible areas of the stator laminations remains (less than 0.01 mCi total mixed fission and activation products).

The motor will be returned Alaron as radioactive equipment after balancing is complete.

Any radioactive waste from the job will be shipped to ALARON's Wampum, Pennsylvania facility. EMC employees who have received ALARON's radiation worker training will perform the work under the supervision of an ALARON senior health physics technician. ALARON will provide survey documentation at the conclusion of work sufficient to justify release for unrestricted use those portions of the EMC facility used.
