The purpose of this modification is to: 1) extend the period of performance from December 31, 2007 to June 29, 2007 at a no cost extension to allow for completion of Task 8. The revision to the regulatory analysis and the OMB paper (Task 8) has been delayed due to a lack of draft regulatory guides that support implementation of the power reactor rulemaking. NRC will not have published all the draft regulatory guides for public comment until December 2007. The public comment period will end in approximately February 2008. Input from industry on the draft regulatory guides and senior management needs to be incorporated into the final rule package that includes the revised regulatory analysis and OMB paper. 2) Change the NRC Project Officer Authority to Rachel Glaros. Accordingly, the task order is hereby modified:

The Period of Performance is hereby revised to read as follows:
