- Feb. 26, 1963 Letter to Martin-Marietta Corp. giving notice that Special Nuclear Material License No. SNM-53 expires on April 30, 1963.
- Mar. 28, 1963 Application submitted by the Martin Co. for renewal of License SNM-53 (Application sent to CB on 4/4/63; criticality review completed on 7/19/63).
- Mar. 29, 1963 Letter from the Martin Co. transmitting Amendment No. 18 to License SNM-53 entitled "In-Process Storage Box" for special nuclear material.
