
This is a Freedom of Information Act Request ("FOIA") pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(3) and 10 C.F.R. § 9.23. This request pertains a combined license ("COL") application that was submitted to the NRC on September 20, 2007 by STP Nuclear Operating Company ("STPNOC"). The application was accepted for docketing by the NRC in a November 29, 2007 letter to STPNOC. The Docket Numbers for proposed Units 3 & 4 are 52-012 and 52-013, respectively.

The NRC performed its acceptance review of the COL application in accordance with NRO Office Instruction NRO-REG-100. The acceptance review for the COL application consists of three parts: (1) administrative processing; (2) a completeness and technical sufficiency review; and (3) the compilation of acceptance review inputs from the technical branches and the decision of whether to docket an application. According to NRO-REG-100, individual technical branch offices must send a memorandum to the Project Manager documenting its review of certain sections of the application - *see Attachment A of NRO-REG-100*.

Specifically, I am requesting the documentation associated with item (3) above (i.e., the memoranda that document the technical reviews for completeness and technical sufficiency) and any emails or internal communications regarding the acceptance review for the STPNOC COL application. The timeframe in which the technical reviews would have taken place was between September 20, 2007 to Present.

I would appreciate your prompt response within ten working days of the receipt of this request, as provided by the Code and the NRC's policies. I agree to pay such fees as required under 10 C.F.R. Paragraph 9.33, *et seq.* without further authorization, however, please call if the fees and copying costs exceed \$300.00
