Gentlemen:

This is to acknowledge receipt of your consolidated application for a superseding license to deliver special nuclear material to a carrier for transport. Since your application dated November 11, 1966, was submitted within three months of the effective date of 10 CFR 71, you may continue to deliver special nuclear material to a carrier for transport under the conditions specified in your existing licenses or approvals, in accordance with the provisions of Section 71.12, 10 CFR 71.

Your application, along with others, will be reviewed as soon as possible. When final action has been taken on your application, the extended authority to deliver to a carrier granted by Section 71.12 will expire, and delivery of special nuclear material to a carrier for transport must then be made under the conditions of such superseding license as may be issued.
