Dear Dr. Lee:

This is in reference to your letter dated November 16, 2007 requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 29-30214-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

In support of your request to authorize Dr. Qaisra Saeed, M.D., and Moein Faghih Vaseghi, M.D., for materials permitted under 10 CFR 35.200, please provide one of the following, as applicable:

- a. Previous license number (if issued by NRC) or a copy of the license (if issued by an Agreement State) on which the physician was specifically named as an authorized user for the uses requested; or
- b. Copy of a board certificate recognized by NRC. Information on the boards that are currently being accepted by the NRC may be found at <http://www.nrc.gov/materials/miau/med-use-toolkit/spec-board-cert.html>. Plus, written certification, signed by a preceptor physician authorized user, stating that the training and experience described in 10 CFR 35.290(a)(1) has been satisfactorily completed and that the proposed authorized user has achieved a level of competency sufficient to function independently as an authorized user for the medical uses under 35.200; or
- c. Description of the training and experience identified in 10 CFR Part 35.290(c)(1), demonstrating that the proposed authorized user is qualified by training and experience for the use of 35.200 materials. Plus, written certification, signed by a preceptor physician authorized user, stating that the training and experience described in 10 CFR 35.290(a)(1) has been satisfactorily completed and that the proposed authorized user has achieved a level of competency sufficient to function independently as an authorized user for the medical uses under 35.200.
