

Control No. 316579: An error (requiring issuance of a corrected copy) has been identified in License Condition 11. of recently issued new License Number 24-32674-01, dated October 10, 2007, to Midwest Cardiology Associates, P.C.

SUMMARY  
In the telephone conversation, with Dr. Bloom, I related that the error involved designation of an Alternate Radiation Safety Officer, which is contrary to current NRC regulation, as specified in 10 CFR 35.24 (b) which specifies that a single individual (the designated Radiation Safety Officer) is to be responsible for implementing the licensee's radiation protection program.

ACTION REQUIRED  
Licensee to request (please reference the request as additional information to Control No. 316579) that the position of Alternate Radiation Safety Officer be deleted from the subject license, by deletion of License Condition 11. B. from License No. 24-32674-01. Please address response to "U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III; Materials Licensing Branch; 2443 Warrenville Road, Suite 210; Lisle, IL 60532-4352" and send it to my attention, by facsimile at 630-515-1078. No followup hard copy is needed. The license reviewer will then issue a corrected copy of the license, with the requested change, in order to meet the regulatory criteria as specified in 10 CFR 35.24(b).
