

Dear Wayne:

Reference is made to your letter of August 7, 1980 regarding formerly used sites in connection with source material licenses for and/or operations at these sites.

In direct answer to your questions:

- (1) No, there was never any State license issued to either Martin Marietta Corp., Baltimore, Maryland or W.R. Grace Company, Baltimore, Maryland authorizing similar nuclear operations after the AEC license expired.
- (2) (a) No, the State has not conducted a radiological survey of the premises. We don't know what buildings these operations were carried out in, or whether those buildings even exist any more. We assume that the AEC did a close-out survey when these operations were terminated since each of the licenses referred to in your letter were terminated prior to Maryland's becoming an Agreement State in 1971.
  - (b) See our answer to no. 2(a) above; and,
  - (c) Refer again to answer to 2(a) above.

I hope this will satisfactorily answer your questions.
