Re: Request compatibility review of supplementary Part 71 license condition for PA licenses

Dear Mr. Lewis;

The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has incorporated NRC regulations by reference. However, changes to the numbering of Part 71 regulations effective in 2007 rendered the incorporation by reference incomplete. Pennsylvania instituted rulemaking to correct this. It is expected that the Final Form rule will become effective in the middle to end of March 2008 just prior to the planned time frame for Pennsylvania to become an Agreement State. Until the Final Form rule is effective, Pennsylvania will issue a supplementary condition to all PA licenses that will have the same effect as the Final Rule. An explanatory letter will accompany the mailing of this Supplementary license condition to all PA licensees.

We request that your office review this license condition for adequacy and compatibility before it is imposed on PA licensees.

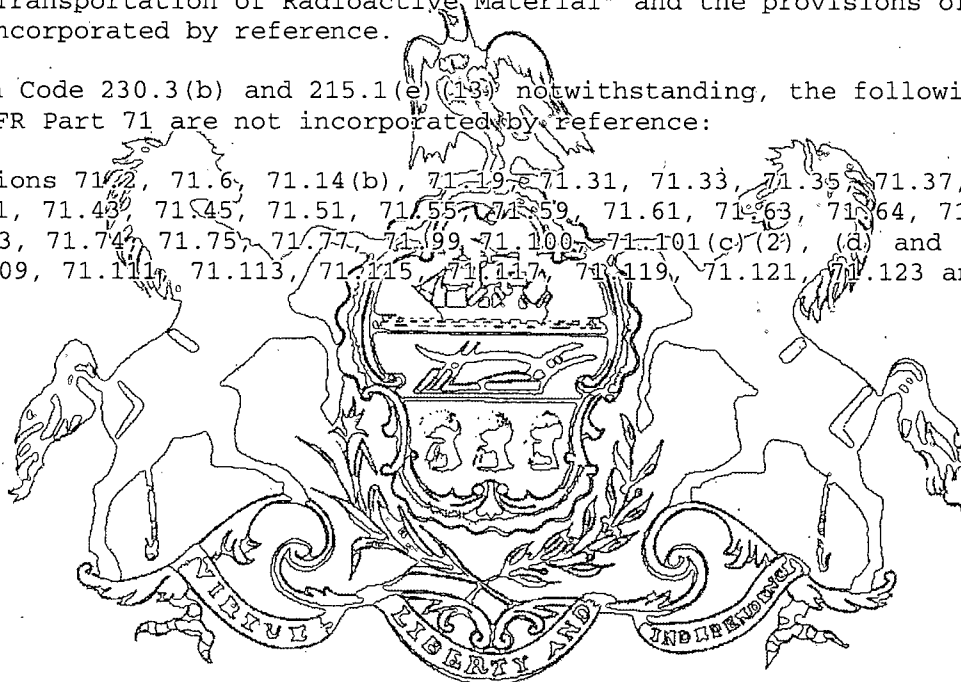
