Dear Ms. Farrell:

I would like to withdraw Mr. Harry D. Felsher and nominate Mr. Thomas J. Marenchin as the authorized U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) representative on the working group for ANSI/ANS 8.10, "Criteria for Nuclear Criticality Safety Controls in Operations with Shielding and Confinement." Mr. Marenchin is a criticality safety inspector and is responsible for conducting independent inspections of criticality safety programs at fuel cycle facilities regulated by NRC.
