

RESOLUTION NO.: 07-1070

VILLAGE OF AIRMONT

TITLE: A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE UNITED STATES SENATE PASS S. 2488 AND THE UNITED STATES HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES PASS H.R. 4891 - TO REQUIRE THE NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION TO CONDUCT AN INDEPENDENT SAFETY ASSESSMENT OF THE INDIAN POINT NUCLEAR POWER PLANT

WHEREAS, Entergy, Inc. is the owner and operator of two nuclear power plants known as Indian Point 2 ("IP2") and Indian Point 3 ("IP3"), located in Buchanan, New York; and

WHEREAS, The Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") is the federal regulatory agency overseeing and licensing IP2 and IP3; and

WHEREAS, the NRC has the power and authority to mandate an Independent Safety Assessment ("ISA") of IP2 and IP3; and

WHEREAS, the NRC in spite of the problems and safety issues experienced by IP2 and IP3 has refused to mandate an ISA of IP2 and IP3; and

WHEREAS, legislation has been introduced in both Houses of Congress, that mandates the NRC to conduct a Maine Yankee style ISA on the vital systems of Indian point and require F.E.M.A. to justify, with specificity, its approval of the IP evacuation plan despite findings of the 2003 Witt Report; and

WHEREAS, the Attorneys General of the States of New York and Connecticut support this legislation as well as the New York State Comptroller; and

WHEREAS, taking into consideration the historical safety record of Indian point, the ~~current uncontrolled leaks of radioactive materials~~ as compared to the health and safety of the residents of the Lower Hudson Valley region;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby

RESOLVED, that the Village of Airmont requests that the United States Senate pass S. 2488 and the United States House of Representatives pass H.R. 4891 entitled "An Act To Require the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to Conduct an Independent Assessment of the Indian Point Power Plant; and it is further


RESOLVED, that the residents around Indian point ~~deserve to have an accurate assessment of safety problems currently known or discovered;~~ and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Village Clerk be and is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this Resolution to Hon. George W. Bush, President of the United States; Hon.

Member of United States House of Representatives

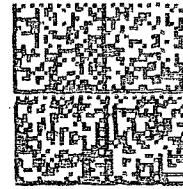
Trustee Meyers moved the Resolution and Trustee Valenti seconded. All were in

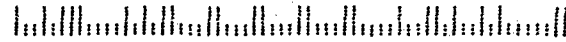


On behalf of President Bush, thank you for your recent correspondence regarding the Indian Point Nuclear Plant. The President is dedicated to diversifying America's energy sources to lessen our dependence on foreign oil and to improve the environment.

The President encourages continued advancements in this industry, improvements in safety and efficiency at nuclear plants, safe disposal of nuclear waste and development of technology that reduces the amount and toxicity of nuclear waste going forward. He encourages the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to expedite applications for new, advanced technology reactors, with the top criteria being safety and environmental protection. Furthermore, the President has encouraged the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to re-license existing plants that meet or exceed safety standards.

As you may know, the U.S. Congress has called for the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to perform an independent safety assessment of the Indian Point Nuclear Plant. Once this legislation has been approved in Congress, the President will carefully review and consider the bill's merits.

I have taken the liberty of forwarding your letter to Secretary Bodman at the U.S. Department of Energy for his review and consideration. Please do not hesitate to contact Bill Behrens or me if we can be of further assistance to you.
